Leslie Sibert is Vice President, Distribution for Georgia Power. In this position, she oversees the company's distribution system, including planning, maintenance, operations and design and construction.

Sibert started with Georgia Power as a co-op student in 1982. She has since held various positions at both Georgia Power and Southern Company in retail/wholesale marketing, distribution, customer service and labor relations. Prior to her current position, she also served as Vice President of Transmission.

During Sibert's tenure at Georgia Power and Southern Company, she has been active in numerous community and business organizations. She currently serves as the Chair of the YWCA of Greater Atlanta Board and Vice Chair of the Georgia Tech Research Corporation Board and Georgia Tech Applied Research Corporation Board, and serves on the advisory boards of Georgia Tech Women In Engineering, Georgia Tech Electrical and Computing Engineering, and Spelman College ASPIRE Program. Sibert also serves as the Southern Company Distribution executive on the Electric Power Research



Institute's Power Delivery & Utilization Sector Council and as the Chair for the Executive Board of the Georgia Industrial Construction Coalition.

Sibert is a graduate of the Georgia Institute of Technology with a Bachelor of Electrical Engineering degree. She completed the Harvard Professional Management Development

Program in 2001 and the Atlanta Regional Leadership Institute program in 2003.

Sibert was inducted into the Academy of Distinguished Engineering Alumni at Georgia Institute of Technology in 2005. In 2007, she participated in the International Women's Forum Fellows Program and was named Alumna Woman of Distinction at the 2007 Georgia Tech Women's Conference. Additionally in 2007, *Atlanta Woman* magazine named Sibert one of its "Top 25 Power Women to Watch." She received the National Association of Women Business Owners (NAWBO) Atlanta Chapter's first "We Advocate – Corporate Executive Award" in 2008 and was recognized by Atlanta's *Business to Business* magazine as one of the 2009 recipients of the "Women of Excellence" awards.
