Interconnection Process



Customer Approves Application - Once the application is submitted, the customer will receive an email asking if they approve the application.

Application Review – A Georgia Power Project Manager will review the application and approve it if no edits are needed.

Application Edits – The project will be returned to the applicant if any edits or updates are needed.

Application Rereview – The Georgia Power Project manager will rereview the application if any edits or updates were made.

Application Complete Pending Install – The applicant will need to submit a form in PowerClerk indicating the installation is complete, passed inspection, and is ready for witness testing. The customer will then receive an email asking them to confirm the completion of the installation.

Interconnection Agreement – The customer will receive a copy of the interconnection agreement via DocuSign. The agreement will need to be reviewed for accuracy and signed electronically.

Meter & Witness Test – A Georgia Power meterman will visit the location of the solar installation to perform the witness test and reprogram the meter to bi-directional.

Permission to Operate – Once all steps have been successfully completed, the customer will receive an email from Georgia Power granting permission to turn their system on and begin generating.
